Mom and Dad were a little concerned. "I think Paige needs to see an eye doctor," her mom said.



The next morning, Mom told Paige that she didn't have to go to school that day. Paige was excited!


Paige was NOT excited when Mom told her they were going to see the eye doctor instead. "I can see just fine!" she said.
