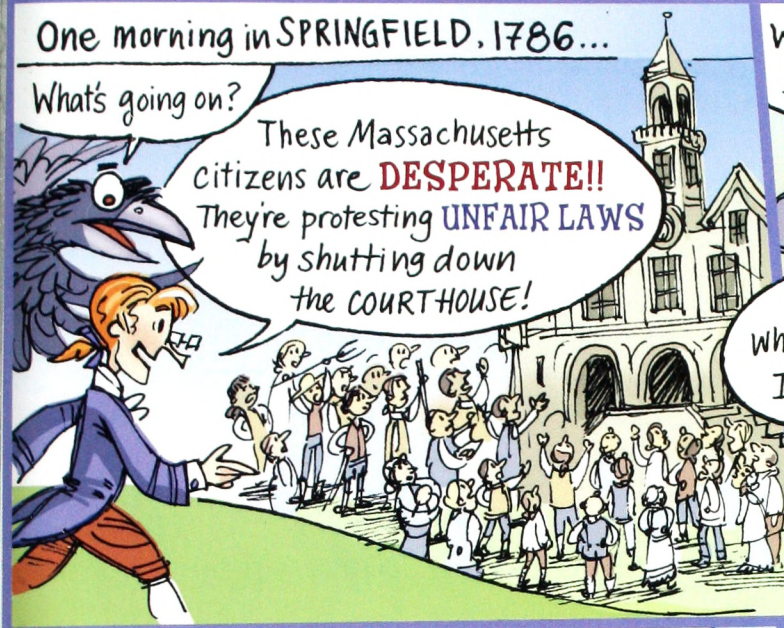


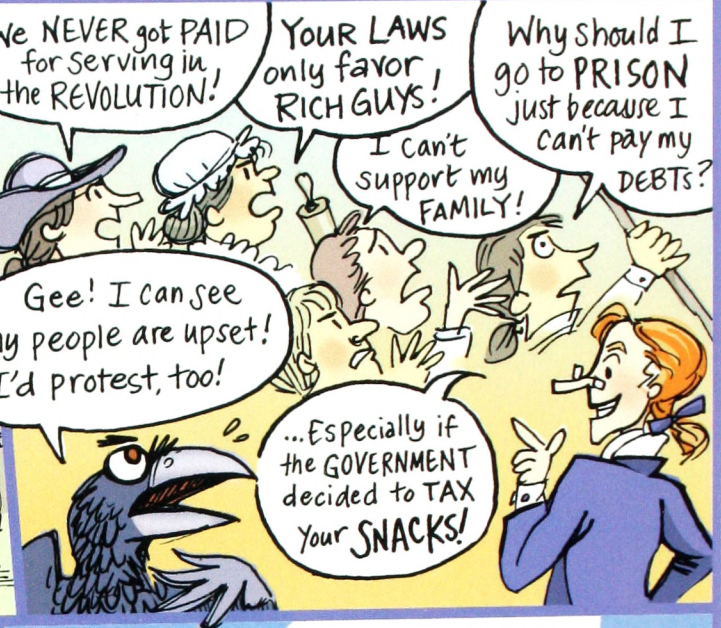
Cartoon Connection with EBENEZER & The COLONEL by KE Lewis

We NEVER got PAID for serving in the REVOLUTION!

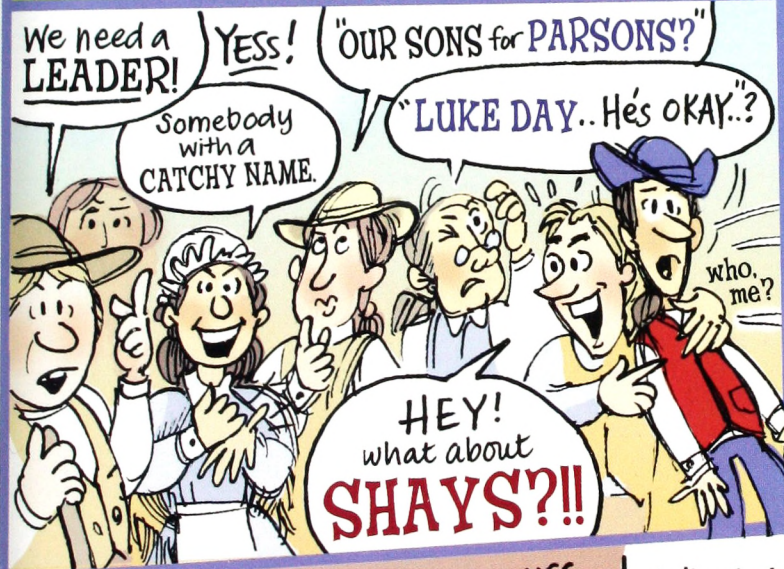
Your LAWS only favor RICH GUYS!
