




tools

Wow, there sure are a lot of tools. I'll get my wagon to carry the ones we need.




I'll help with the wood. Don't forget your safety glasses.

Oh boy! I love working with tools!


This toolbelt keeps everything so organized!

It helps to have the right tools!




And a hammer will help us nail them onto the tree.

What luck! A perfect fit! Let's hammer it into place.


OUCH!! I got a splinter.
